**Baptism:** Parents must be registered in the parish for 3 months and attend a baptism preparation class. Call the church office to sign up.\*

**Pastoral Care:** Holy Communion may be received at home, in a nursing home or in the hospital. If you find you are unable to attend Mass and want to receive Communion, you or an immediate family member may call the office to make the necessary arrangements.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Those who may be in danger of death should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick promptly by contacting the parish or Father Tebalt at church after the weekend Masses.

**Facilities:** The facilities and services of Our Lady of Lourdes are available to active members who fulfill the requirements. This includes the use of the church for all Sacramental Events.

**NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**FROM THE PASTOR**

Summer is rapidly coming to an end, which means the beginning of a new school year and the beginning of a new religious education year. Be sure to register your child early for religious education!

This Tuesday, August 15th, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: a HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION. Masses will be offered at 12 Noon and at 6 p.m. on the Holy Day. Put it on your calendar now, if you haven't already done so.

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius X issued the Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*, which solemnly declared the dogma of the Assumption. In the document, he wrote: "By the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." While the dogma was only defined in 1950, the belief was held as far back as at least the year 377. (It's worth noting that the Church isn't always in a big hurry about defining things — and there are reasons for that, but that would be another column).

The Assumption means that Mary was taken up body and soul ("assumed into heaven," in other words). Did she die before that happened? Pius X left that an open question (again, no need to define things that don't absolutely have to be defined) by his use of the phrase "having completed the course of her earthly life." Some Catholics believe that Mary was assumed into heaven without having first undergone bodily death. Others believe that she died first, but then was resurrected prior to being assumed. The Orthodox and Eastern Rite Catholics refer to the Assumption as the "Dormition of the Theotokos" (the Falling Asleep of the Mother of God) and believe that, like Jesus, she first underwent bodily death and was resurrected on the third day after her death, in anticipation of the general resurrection at the end of time. Personally, that interpretation makes the most sense to me, but, as I said, the question was left open.

Please note that there will be no daily Masses this Thursday, August 17th and Friday, August 18th. I will be out of town for a couple of days.

While it is yet a bit down the road, those who are interested might want to mark down on their calendars that on Thursday, September 14th, at 7 p.m. at Prince of Peace Catholic Church in Taylors (Greenville) a Solemn High Mass in the Extraordinary Form (aka, the Traditional Latin Mass) will be celebrated. That day is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The Mass will also be offered in thanksgiving for Pope Benedict's XVI's *Motu Proprio Summorum Pontificum*, which gave every priest of the Latin Church the right to celebrate the older form of Mass and which also gave the laity of the Church the right to request that Mass and have that request treated charitably.
