Baptism: Parents must be registered in the parish for 3 months and attend a baptism preparation class. Call the church office to sign up.*

Marriage Preparation: Call Father Tebalt at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to schedule an appointment.

Pastoral Care: Holy Communion may be received at home, in a nursing home or in the hospital. If you find you are unable to attend Mass and want to receive Communion, you or an immediate family member may call the office to make the necessary arrangements.

Anointing of the Sick: Those who may be in danger of death should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick promptly by contacting the parish or Father Tebalt at church after the weekend Masses.

Facilities: The facilities and services of Our Lady of Lourdes are available to active members who fulfill the requirements. This includes the use of the church for all Sacramental Events.

FROM THE PASTOR

Registration for religious education continues this weekend. Be sure to get your children signed up!

Tuesday, August 22, is the feast of the Queenship of Mary. The day, one week after the Assumption, commemorates the Catholic understanding of Mary as Queen of Heaven. Mary's queenship is, of course, tied to the kingship of Jesus. "The mother of the king is the queen," as it were. The title "Queen Mother," familiar to modern ears, is the way in which Mary's queenship is understood.

Christ is the fulfillment of the Old Covenant, and in the Old Testament there are many references to the *gebirah*, the "Great Lady" (the usual way of referring to the mother of the Davidic kings), translated into English as "queen" or "queen-mother." These women held great power as advocates with the king. One of the most prominent examples is Bathsheba, the mother of King Solomon. In I Kings 2:20, Solomon says to Bathsheba, whom he has seated on a throne at his right hand, "Make your request, my mother, for I will not refuse you." This is Old Testament image for Mary's intercessory role. In the New Testament, it is seen at the Wedding at Cana (John 2: 1-11) and as the Woman Clothed With the Sun (Revelation 12: 1-3).
