Pastoral Care: Holy Communion may be received at home, in a nursing home or in the hospital. If you find you are unable to attend Mass and want to receive Communion, you or an immediate family member may call the office to make the necessary arrangements.

Anointing of the Sick: Those who may be in danger of death should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick promptly by contacting the parish or Father Tebalt at church after the weekend Masses.

Facilities: The facilities and services of Our Lady of Lourdes are available to active members who fulfill the requirements. This includes the use of the church for all Sacramental Events.

FROM THE PASTOR

Please remember that we are taking up a special second collection (across the Diocese of Charleston) this weekend and next for Hurricane Harvey relief. If you contribute by check, please make it payable to OLOL and write "hurricane relief" in the memo line. All monies will be forwarded to the diocese, which will combine donations from all parishes and send on to Catholic Relief Services.

This Thursday, September 14th, is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. A Solemn High Mass in the extraordinary (traditional) form will be celebrated at Prince of Peace Catholic Church (1209 Brushy Creek Road) in Taylors at 7 p.m. that evening. As I will be participating in that Mass as one of the sacred ministers, there will be no 5:30 p.m. Mass that day here at OLOL, nor will there be an 8 a.m. Mass Friday morning. The Solemn High at Prince of Peace in the extraordinary (traditional) form is being offered in thanksgiving for Pope Benedict XVI's motu proprio letter, "Summorum pontificum," which gave to every priest of the Roman Church the right to celebrate the extraordinary form of the Roman Rite.

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross commemorates the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem in the year 335. Although the actual dedication took place on September 13th of the year 335, it was on the next day (September 14th) that the True Cross was brought outside the church for public veneration. The True Cross had been discovered in the year 326 during excavations sponsored by St. Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine. Constantine was, of course, the Roman emperor who issued the Edict of Milan which put an end to the persecution of Christians in the Roman Empire. The True Cross was divided into three parts: one part remained in Jerusalem, one part was taken to the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Rome; and the last part was taken to Constantinople.
