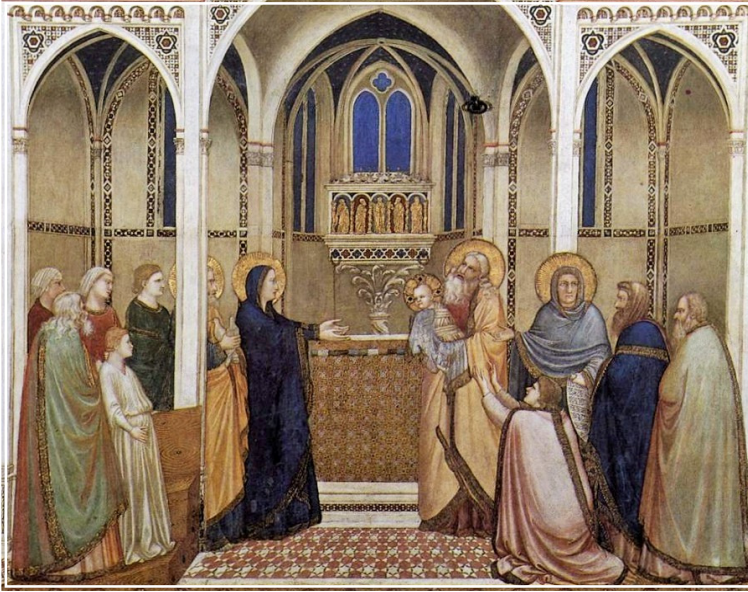

**RCIA:** September through May - Meets on First and Third Thursdays of each month at 6:30 p.m.

**Baptism:** Parents must be registered in the parish for 3 months and attend a baptism preparation class. Call the church office to sign up.\*

**Marriage Preparation:** Call Father Tebalt at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to schedule an appointment.

**Pastoral Care:** Holy Communion may be received at home, in a nursing home or in the hospital. If you find you are unable to attend Mass and want to receive Communion, you or an immediate family member may call the office to make the necessary arrangements.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Those who may be in danger of death should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick promptly by contacting the parish or Father Tebalt at church after the weekend Masses.

**Facilities:** The facilities and services of Our Lady of Lourdes are available to active members who fulfill the requirements. This includes the use of the church for all Sacramental Events.

**Diocesan Office of Child Protection:** Our Lady of Lourdes and the Diocese of Charleston are committed to ensuring a safe environment for children. THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

**FROM THE PASTOR**

Please note that this coming Thursday, February 1st is First Thursday. The 5:30 p.m. Mass will be followed, as is customary, by the Knights of Columbus-sponsored Rosary for the Culture of Life.

Friday, February 2nd, is First Friday. We will, as usual, have Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament following the 8 a.m. Mass. But this First Friday is even more special, since February 2nd is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (commonly called *Candlemas*). This feast commemorates Mary and Joseph bringing the infant Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem, 40 days after His birth, to perform the ritual of the Redemption of the Firstborn Son (as indicated in Leviticus 12 and Exodus 13). The event is recounted in Luke 2: 22-40.

Upon bringing Jesus to the Temple, Mary and Joseph are met by the prophet Simeon, whom God had promised that he would not see death until he had beheld the Christ. Taking the infant Jesus in his arms, Simeon uttered the prayer which would come to be known as the *Nunc Dimittis*. This canticle is recited each and every night by the Church in the Office of Compline (Night Prayer). It goes (in English), "Lord, now you let your servant go in peace; your word has been fulfilled: my own eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared in the sight of every people: a light to reveal you to the nations and the glory of your people Israel."

Because Christ is the light of the world, and Simeon, upon the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, refers to him as a light of revelation to the nations, it became customary to bless the parish candles on this day. The Mass begins with a lovely candlelight procession. Please join us if your schedule permits — and bring candles for your home to be blessed during the Mass.
