Baptism: Parents must be registered in the parish for 3 months and attend a baptism preparation class. Call the church office to sign up.*

Marriage Preparation: Call Father Tebalt at least 6 months prior to your wedding date to schedule an appointment.

Pastoral Care: Holy Communion may be received at home, in a nursing home or in the hospital. If you find you are unable to attend Mass and want to receive Communion, you or an immediate family member may call the office to make the necessary arrangements.

Anointing of the Sick: Those who may be in danger of death should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick promptly by contacting the parish or Father Tebalt at church after the weekend Masses.

Facilities: The facilities and services of Our Lady of Lourdes are available to active members who fulfill the requirements. This includes the use of the church for all Sacramental Events.

Diocesan Office of Child Protection: Our Lady of Lourdes and the Diocese of Charleston are committed to ensuring a safe environment for children. Finally, a reminder to all who may be wondering: within the Province of Atlanta (which includes our diocese), the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension has been permanently transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. This means that the Mass of the Ascension will take place next weekend (Saturday at 5 p.m. and Sunday at 9:30 a.m. in English and at 6 p.m. in Spanish). That also means that Thursday, May 10, is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation. The daily Mass that day is the Memorial of St. Damien of Veuster, who gave his life in service to the lepers at the colony on Molokai, Hawaii.
